I would like to thank the NDSURF Board and foundation staff for their efforts over the last year in helping the foundation move toward a more sustainable business model.

The working group that was established in FY18 to review the structure of the foundation met and made a recommendation to the NDSURF Board of Directors that the foundation continue with its current structure. At the same meeting, the Board voted to remove the Interim designation from my title.

Henry Nowak, Technology Licensing Manager, left NDSU and the foundation for the opportunity to lead technology transfer efforts at another land grant university. A search is currently underway to refill this position.


Research Fee and Royalty revenues for FY19 were \$1.13M . As in previous years the crops generating the most revenue for the foundation were wheat, potatoes, and edible beans. More detailed information about the varieties generating revenue for the foundation can be found on page 2 of this report.

Current indications are that FY20 will see increased research fee and royalty revenue for the foundation but there is still uncertainty due to the current geo-political climate.

#### **Plant Sciences**

Eleven new plant varieties were released in FY19. Three of them were edible beans, 'ND Whitetail' white kidney bean, 'ND Falcon' pinto bean, and 'ND Pegasus' great northern bean. The NDSU Edible Bean Breeder is Juan Osorno.



#### Horticulture



The FireFlare Orange® Mollis Azalea was released this year for licensing to wholesale nurseries. This selection was grown and outplanted in Fargo, ND in the early 1970's. The flowers are a very showy brilliant fire-orange. USDA hardiness zones 3b—8. A registered trademark issued in September 2019 for this cultivar.

#### Technologies:

Seventeen other disclosures came from various departments across campus including Chemistry and Biochemistry, Agricultural and Biosystems Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical and Computer Engineering, Coatings and Polymeric Materials, Microbiological Sciences, Pharmaceutical Sciences and Human Development and Family Science. Five patents were filed to protect selected technologies that were novel, non-obvious, and useful in that aspect that a company would potentially want to license it.

#### **Patents and Trademarks**

The NDSU Research Foundation was awarded eight issued patents in FY19, which included five U.S. patents, one European patent, and two South Korean patents. One Canadian registered trademark was granted for Spring Welcome® Magnolia

#### Joint Invention Highlight

The Energy & Environmental Research Center (EERC) and NDSU, working together on a Department of Energy (DOE) program, have a jointly shared invention on which a provisional patent was filed. This invention is a more efficient way to make ammonia, the single most energy-intensive chemical in the world. Over 1% of total annual worldwide energy consumption goes toward making ammonia. The new technology is centered on an electrochemical membrane comprising an EERC-developed proton-conducting material strategically composited by NDSU in a high-temperature polymer. The resulting membrane offers the potential to reduce ammonia production energy consumption, associated greenhouse gas emissions, and cost by 20%.


